

# CREATING A DATA MANAGEMENT PLAN(DMP)

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## What is a DMP?

- Documentation that **evolves** during the life of the project
- Description des **metadata**
- **Identification of key stages**, from data collection to data archiving/destruction



## Why create a DMP?

- To guarantee continuity, reproducibility and accessibility (**Open Science**)
- Ensuring **data traceability**
- Attesting to the **responsibility of project participants**

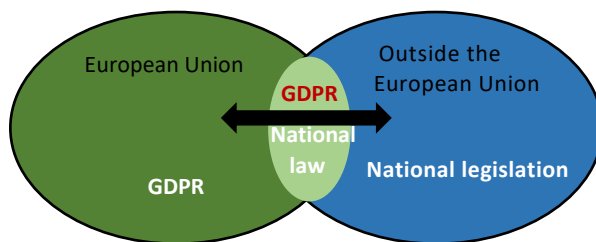


## General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)



- Implemented on May 24, **2018**
- Protection of personal data of **European citizens as well as of others**
- Applies to **natural persons** (and farms)

Regulation applying in the **European Union**



## Personal Data (PD)



- Any information that makes it possible to **identify a person directly or indirectly**
- PD must be **as open as possible, but as closed as necessary**

## When am I concerned?



- **Personal data personnel**
- Data collection or processing after **2018 in the EU**

## What are the penalties?



1. Fines of up to **20 millions d'euros** for public entities
2. Fines of up to **4% of worldwide sales** for private companies
3. Damage to **the quality and scientific reputation** of the institutes concerned

## The DPO's role



The **Data Protection Officer (DPO)** monitors compliance of the DMPs with the GDPR

## Before conducting the survey



- One person responsible **per country and per institute**
- Maximum **10 years'** data retention after the end of the project
- Data may only be used for **the sole purpose of the research, for the duration of project's usefulness**
- Compliance with laws of **non-European countries**

## What do I need to do for my survey?



- **Individual information sheet** for each respondent
- **Consent forms** to retain
  - Clear, understandable, precise
  - Text or audio format

## Key points

- **Justify** surveys of vulnerable people (minors, people in retirement homes, etc.)
- **Secure data** by using the institute's internal servers
- **Avoid** storing data only on workstations
- **Anticipate** potential data cross-fertilization (data may become sensible when cross-fertilized)
- **Consider** the possibility of unintentional collection of connection data (IP) during an online survey



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
